

2023 BUFFALO ROUNDUP & ARTS FESTIVAL

DATE AND LOCATION:

Custer State Park Arts Festival is held annually on the last weekend of September in the meadow west of the State Game Lodge.

The festival will be held September 28th, 2023, through September 30th, 2023.

VENDOR FESTIVAL HOURS ARE:

- Wednesday September 27th, 8am to 5pm. Vendor set-up.
- Thursday September 28th, 10am to 6pm. Open to public.
- Friday September 29th, 10am to 6pm. Open to public.
- Saturday September 30th, 9am to 4pm. Open to public.

Please note that this is an outdoor event and inclement weather is possible, Custer State Park reserves the right to decide whether to end/cancel the festival. Our policy is to PROCEED RAIN, SNOW OR SHINE unless the severity of the weather conditions poses the threat of harm to our Vendors and guests. This decision is solely that of Custer State Park.

REGISTRATION, SET-UP AND TEAR-DOWN

Vendor Check-in: Vendors must check-in on Wednesday or Thursday to receive registration packets with vendor ID cards and parking passes. All day Wednesday and Thursday morning before the festival begins, you will be able to drive to your vendor spot to unload your goods and set up tents.

DRIVE SLOWLY, BE COURTEOUS AND KIND, BE MINDFUL OF PEDESTRIANS, BE MINDFUL OF DAMAGING OUR GROUNDS.

BOOTHS, FEES AND APPLICATIONS:

The cost of a 20'x20' booth space is \$200 for all three days.

You are responsible in providing your own equipment such as tables, tents and other necessities needed to operate your booth and secure your goods. Electricity is NOT available, and you are responsible for all payment processing and sales of your goods and must have proper tax licenses and permits to do so.

One exempt pass and parking pass per paid applicant will be issued to provide free entrance into the park for the duration of the weekend. Lodging and camping is available in the park on a limited basis. Make your reservations early. Camping at the Festival grounds is prohibited.

STANDARDS & RULES

CANCELLATION and REFUND for all artists and vendors:

If you cancel, 100% credit towards next year's Arts Festival, however, you must apply to and be juried into that event. Credits are good for one year after the date given.

Cancellations made within 7 days of the event will not receive either a refund or credit.

- **Original Artwork or Crafts** created by the Vendor
 - Mass produced or commercially bought items must be modified considerably by the Vendor.
 - Absolutely no Home Improvements Options or Food Vendors/Trucks.
- **No trademarked logos** are allowed, including "Custer State Park Buffalo Round-up."
- **All work must be appropriate for a general audience**, including children. Custer State Park reserves the right to review products at any time for continued compliance. Vendors found with products that do not meet show qualifications will be required to remove the items or leave the show. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from future Festivals and possible removal from the current show.
- **Trash:** Vendors are responsible for removing their own garbage from their booth space after the festival. Custer State Park provides a dumpster on site that vendors may use. Trash left behind is cause for disqualification of future events.
- **Tax and Sales Rules:** All Vendors must collect local & state sales tax. Forms will be provided in your Vendor Packets. General rule for South Dakota is if you do less than 3 shows in SD, you do not need a SD tax ID Number.
- **Special Interest Groups:** Groups or persons seeking to promote political expression, social commentary, or special interests are strictly prohibited from Festival grounds. Exception is 1 of each Democrat & Republican booth to help Attendees to Vote.
- **Slander:** Custer State Park will not tolerate slander on social media, blogs, In-Person, or of any kind. Slandering Custer State Park Festival will result in immediate removal from the current Festival and any future event. If you have a grievance, please come to us directly—we are happy to meet with you.

Security is not provided, but Custer State Park Rangers do keep an eye on the festival grounds.

Custer State Park Resort is an authorized concessionaire of South Dakota's Department of Game, Fish & Parks, serving the public in Custer State Park.
