## Duties & Expectations:

- Receives training and performs duties as assigned in several departments, with examples being dining room, kitchen, front desk, housekeeping, lounge, banquets & catering.
- Learns line and staff functions, operations, management viewpoints and company policies and practices that affect each phase of the resort business.
- Works long hours; frequently moves from department to department as the need arises, to support fellow staff members in achieving the company mission.

Two (2) MIT positions are available at each of the park's four lodges. One MIT position is available in the Sales/Marketing Department, who is responsible for assisting with sales, catering, banquets & events. Up to two (2) internships are available within the Human Resources Department and assist largely with hiring, payroll, timeclock systems, recruiting material, employee appreciation, and other duties as assigned.

While this position suits recent college grads best, college enrollment is not required. Preference is given to MITs who can work the entire season from May 15-October 15. Limited positions are available from May 15-August 15 for candidates with a history of strong work ethic.
