ABOUT THE STATE GAME LODGE

This gracious stone and wood lodge is set in a beautiful mountain valley, surrounded by a Ponderosa pine forest. Grace Coolidge Creek winds through the valley and offers excellent trout fishing. Oak, birch and aspen trees line the babbling creek, providing a colorful, year-round display.

The State Game Lodge served as the “Summer White House” for President Calvin Coolidge in 1927 and was visited by President Dwight D. Eisenhower for several days in 1953. It was built in 1920, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
